Tips, Tricks and How to's

# Filter Cleaning

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*The filter in your hot tub play a very important role in keeping your water clean and safe. If you are using pleated filters, it will require cleaning every couple weeks and a deep cleaning every 3-4 months.*

Here is what you are going to need to clean your filters.

1. A large pail
2. Brush
3. Filter Cleaner
4. Adjustable nozzle for garden hose
5. Gloves
6. Protective eyewear

**\*\* Do not use pressure washers to clean filters, as it will damage and/or destroy the pleats.**

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*If you are using pleated filters it is a good habit to remove the filter every couple weeks and give it a good rinse*

Here is how to clean your filter(s).

1. Remove filter(s) from filter canister
2. Gently rinse with a hose while agitating with a brush to remove any loose debris
3. Separate the pleats and rinse in between
4. Return filter(s) to the cannister

**\*\* DO NOT leave anything floating around in the spa while filters are out. Ensure that nothing is running while you remove filters.**

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**Deep Cleaning** - *If you are using a pleated filter(s) this is a must everytime you drain your spa. Manufacturers recommend you have two sets of filters. After being cleaned the filter needs to dry 100% before it can be put back in the hot tub.*

Here is how to clean your filter(s).

1. Remove filter(s) from filter canister
2. Gently rinse with a hose while agitating with a brush to remove any loose debris
3. Separate the pleats and rinse in between
4. Place the filter in the bucket with the filter cleaner. **(Follow instructions on bottle)**
5. Rinse the filter thoroughly and let it dry.
